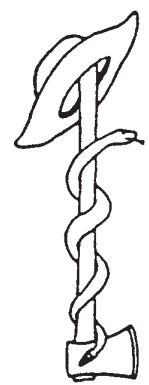

- Wheelchair accessible

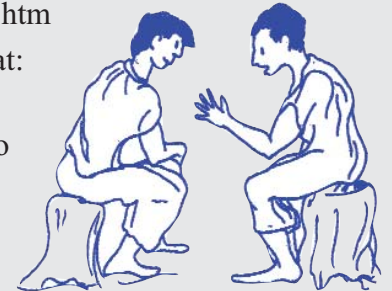
